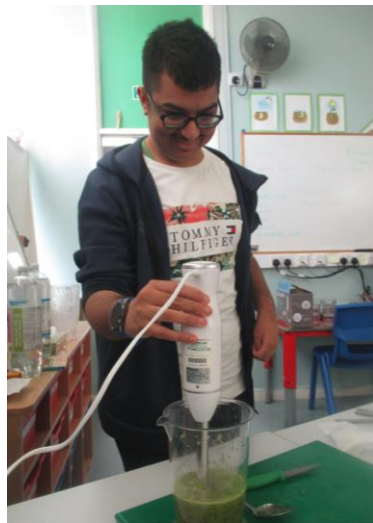


Dear Parents
